



Flow Art Space in St Paul, Minnesota announces an Open Call for **submissions for exhibitions to be held during the second half of 2014**. During this Open Call artists will be considered for possible inclusion in group exhibitions and/or chosen as a featured artist.

2D and 3D media and all subject matter will be considered, including but not limited to drawing, painting, photography, book art, printmaking, sculpture, fiber, glass, encaustic, ceramics, mixed media, wood, digital art, video, installation, etc. Exhibition themes are curated in response to the work submitted during this open call. Flow Art Space Founder Melissa Metzler will select work.

- Early deadline to submit work is May 28, 2013. Final deadline to submit is June 18, 2014. Submission fee increases after the early deadline (read details below).
- Group show submission: early submission fee is \$35 for 3 images or \$15 if you are submitting 1 image only (May 28 deadline), final deadline submission fee is \$45 for 3 images or \$20 for 1 image (June 18 deadline). Additional images may be submitted for \$5/image.
- Featured artist submission: you must submit a minimum of 6 images in order to be considered as a featured artist. Early submission fee is \$50 for 6 images (May 28 deadline), final deadline submission fee is \$60 for 6 images (June 18 deadline). Additional images may be submitted for \$5/image. Featured artist applicants must also upload an artist statement with their images.
- Submit by clicking on the words "Smarter Entry" in the Submit Work section on **www.flowartspace.com**. Once paid, submission fees are non-refundable whether or not work is chosen for exhibition. Submission indicates artist agrees with the terms set forth here.
- Artists will be notified on or before June 28, 2014.

Artists are responsible for all shipping/delivery costs before and after each exhibition. Shipped work must include pre-paid, return postage which includes pickup at the gallery.

Flow Art Space does not provide insurance coverage for work exhibited. Work is shown at the artist's own risk. Artists may choose to insure work if they wish.

Artists keep 100% of sales. Artists have a chance to establish ongoing relationships with their buyers because buyers purchase directly from the artists. Artists set their own prices and handle their own transactions by accepting their preferred method(s) of payment. Artists deliver or ship their sold work to buyers where necessary (however, buyers usually pick up at the gallery after artists receive payment). Artists may also submit work for exhibitions that is not for sale.

The mission of Flow Art Space is to provide opportunities for artists to show their work in a professional environment, increase their exposure, and connect them with potential buyers and art community professionals. Flow Art Space presents professional exhibitions, promotes each juried show, and hosts lively receptions. Buyers, curators, gallerists, interior designers, and colleagues are invited and often attend. Flow Art Space does not represent artists but does provide excellent exposure for work.
