Flow Art Space in Salt Lake City UT announces an open call for Utah and all Intermountain West artists to consider artwork for exhibitions in 2018 and early 2019.

2D media with diverse subject matter and a unique approach to creating art are currently sought for exhibition and sale. Drawing, painting, photography, printmaking, fiber, collage, encaustic, mixed media, recycled materials, digital art, video, and installation will be considered. Flow Art Space Founder and Curator Melissa Metzler will select artwork. Artists must be 18+ years of age to submit their work. Selected artists must hand-deliver art that is accepted. No shipments will be received.

- There are several main criteria for selection: unique subject matter; a unique approach to creating art; or an important message. One of these criteria must be combined with high-quality artistic execution in order to be considered.
- There are two application deadlines:
 - June 27 deadline at midnight for fall 2018 exhibitions.
 - September 19 deadline at midnight for winter 2018 and spring 2019 exhibitions.
- Application fee is \$20 for 6 images for consideration and \$40 for 12 images for consideration.
- A link to your website will be requested upon application.
- Artwork uploaded must be available for exhibition (no substituted work will be allowed if selected).
- Once paid, application fees are non-refundable whether or not work is selected for exhibition.
- Applying indicates artist agrees with the terms set forth here.
- Apply by clicking on the words “Smarter Entry” in the **Artists Apply** section on **www.flowartspace.com**.
- All artists who apply will be notified within 2 weeks of applying whether their work is being considered for exhibition. Final decisions will be made just after the application deadlines listed above.

Commission. Flow Art Space promotes exhibitions, provides opportunities for artwork to be seen in a professional environment, increases artwork exposure to the public, and exposes potential buyers and art community professionals to art. Buyers, curators, gallerists, interior designers, and colleagues are invited and often attend shows. In return, Flow Art Space takes a 50 percent commission on all sales of art. The asking price for artwork that is accepted for exhibition will be jointly agreed upon between FAS and the artist based upon estimated market value.
